\* Please note following extract from Rule 7 of the Society: -

In accordance with the provisions of clause 7.3 the Committee shall have the power to elect as Associate Members, at their discretion, other individuals who do not meet the strict criteria of clauses 7.1 and 7.2 but who have an established, close association with the Society, and have played as a guest at a number of Society meetings prior to applying to be an Associate Member, and who the Committee believe will benefit the future of the Society through their membership.

As with Members, all applicants for Associate Members must be members of a recognised Golf Club. Associate Members will be eligible to win society trophies and prizes, and will be subject to the appropriate Member's annual subscription, but Associate Members will be non-voting members of the Society and therefore will not be eligible to be elected as President, Vice-President or Captain of the Society; however, Associate Members will be eligible for election as Honorary Treasurer or Honorary Secretary. Also, Associate Members will be eligible for election as committee members, provide that no more than 2 Associate Members may serve as committee members at any one time. The maximum number of Associate Members will be limited to approximately 25% of the playing membership.
