Please note extract from Rule 7 of the Society: -

7.1 Chartered Engineers of the Institutions of Civil, Mechanical and Engineering & Technology (formerly IEE) and the Institution of Engineers and Shipbuilders in Scotland, shall be eligible to be elected as a Member of the Society, provided they are already members of a recognised Golf Club.

7.2 The Committee shall have the power to elect as Members, at their discretion, other Chartered Engineers (or the Overseas Equivalent), Engineering Graduates and other exceptional candidates who do not meet the strict engineering entry criteria but who are prominent in professions or businesses allied to the engineering profession, provided they are already members of a recognised golf club and provided that at no time shall the number of such members exceed 40.
